

EMERGENCY NURSING PEDIATRIC COURSE

September 29, 30, 2012

University Hospital, San Antonio, TX

Course Description:

The Emergency Nursing Pediatric Course (ENPC) was developed by the National Emergency Nurses Association. This 16 hour course is designed to improve the care of the pediatric patient in all settings and increase the skill and confidence of nurses who care for children. Lectures and skill stations are used to increase the cognitive and technical skills necessary for basic care of the pediatric patient. The course goes beyond trauma and resuscitation to include triage, shock, respiratory and medical emergencies, crisis, maltreatment, neonatal overview, toxicological emergencies, as well as other areas commonly seen in pediatric care settings. Verification of successful course completion is obtained by passing both a written exam and psychomotor skill stations, and is valid for four years.

Target Audience:

Registered Nurses who desire to increase their knowledge base and skill level in caring for pediatric patients. Licensed Vocational Nurses and Paramedics are welcome to take the course, but are not able to be verified through testing; registration fees and continuing education hours are adjusted accordingly.

Registration:

Advanced registration is required and is limited to the first 32 paid applicants. Registration will not be accepted on-site. Registration will not be accepted unless accompanied by payment in full. The registration covers the ENPC provider manual, continuing education certificate, and continental breakfast/snacks. **Registration will be handled on a first come, first serve basis.** Please confirm your place as soon as possible!

If your institution provides partial payment of the course fee, a personal check for the balance must accompany the registration. **Partial payments will not be accepted.**
