Congratulations Yvonne—2008 Nurse Imagemaker

*On a warm, sunny, spring day in late May, nurses, family, and friends gathered at the Oak Hills Country club for the 2008 South Texas Nurse Imagemaker Award presentation sponsored by Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing (Delta Alpha at-Large Chapter) and the Texas Nurses Association (District 8). Thirty-three nurses from different facilities and organizations were awarded the distinction of Nurse Imagemaker. This year's nominee/recipient from the San Antonio ENA was **Yvonne Moseley**.*

Yvonne was nominated because of her high level involvement and long term commitment to the San Antonio Emergency Nurses Association (SAENA) and to SafetyWhys, a babysitter's training course sponsored by the SAENA as part of its injury prevention mission.
